



## Summary of Feedback English Study Tour,

(Thepsatri Rajabhat University, Lopburi Province, Thailand, May 1-7, 2013)

### Average rating of study tour by all students 10 out of 10!

- 100% of students thought that their English has improved with 75% of students writing that their English had improved "a lot" (in a one week program!)
- 100% of students found that their confidence to speak English had improved.
- 100% of students concluded that they spoke English outside the class sometimes with 53% saying they spoke English outside the class "quite a lot"
- 81% of students found that their self confidence in life was higher than before they came.
- 100% of students found their leadership and independence skills better than when they arrived.
- 100% of students said they had a positive home stay experience and found their home stays to be friendly and welcoming.
- The average rating of this study tour was 9.8 out of 10 with 12 out of 17 students giving it a perfect 10!
- This program was a one week program with students aged from 15 to 54, from high school to Master Degree holders and experienced teachers. They were taught together in a one week program and to the nearest whole number their rating for the study tour averaged 10 out of 10 across the group.
- The two leaders rated the program 10 out of 10 and 9.4 out of 10 respectively.

These are fantastic results and say something pretty special about the Thepsatri Rajabhat University staff, the leadership group among the students, as well as those involved in the program here.

As Principal I am thrilled at the feedback from the students and appreciate very much our home stays and our teaching staff. Yet there is still much we can do to further improve this program. Our goal is to run the best study tour programs in Australia and constantly strive to further improve the experiences possible for students.

We are here to change lives and give students more choices more often and send them home with better English, higher self confidence, stronger leadership and self belief.
